Community Outreach Officer to be appointed by Branch Management Committee in 2021 – we request that interested individuals make themselves known to Hon. Secretary. Safeguarding Officer nominated by Branch but appointed by National Safeguarding Committee

Nominations for all the above-mentioned Offices and Management positions are invited from Members, all of whom must be in current membership of the Branch, or duly appointed by the Management Committee.

Nominations must be submitted on the Official Nomination form previously sent and bear the Signatures of the Nominee, Proposer, and Seconder. Electronic signatures are valid and may be validated.

Voting where required shall take place at the AGM in accordance with clause 6.3 of the Branch Constitution: -

"Any resolution put to the vote of a General Meeting of the Branch shall be decided upon a show of hands based on the 'one Member, one Vote' principle adopted at the 2015 AGM. Therefore, any Member present in person shall have one vote only irrespective of the number of offices that member may hold. In the event of an equality of votes upon any resolution, the Chair of the meeting shall have a second or casting vote."

An individual attending the AGM either face to face or virtually as the nominated representative of a Member eligible to vote must, prior to the commencement of the AGM, provide written confirmation of such nomination to the Chair of the meeting (as permitted under clause 12.1 of the Articles of RLSS UK). Please note that since 2015 and the requirement of RLSS UK for Branches to adopt the Revised Model Constitution, Affiliated Member Groups no longer have voting rights.

If written confirmation is not presented and is not signed by an eligible Member then the returning officer will decide if the authorisation form is accepted or not. If two or more individuals submit authorisation forms for the same Member, no vote will be recorded on behalf of that Member.
